pleaseth the great disposer of all things to call, do make this to be my
last will and testament in manner and form Wit first I recommend
my Soul to God who gave it me and hope for a forgiveness of all my sins
through the merits of a crucified Saviour and as for my worldly goods
as it has pleased Almighty God to lend me I give & bequeath in man-
ner following to wit. — Item I give and bequeath unto my son John
Brown my plantation I now live on to him and his heirs for ever but —
should my son John Brown dye without Lawfull heir I give the said
Land to my Daughter Ann Brown to her and her heirs for ever lawfull-
ly begotten — Item my will and desire is that all my personal estate
of what so ever kind it may be sold and the money arising from
the sale thereof after my Just Debts are paid may be Equally divid-
ed between my four Children John Ann Elizabeth and Polly
Brown to them and their heirs for ever — Item my will and desire is that

the Land I have before given to my son John may be rented out untill
he arrives to the age of Twenty one years and the money arising there-
from together with the one fourth of the money arising from the
sale of my personal Estate may be laid out in his schooling -
Lastly I constitute and appoint my Friend William Southall my
executor to this my last will and testament revoking all others in
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Twen-
ty first day of September one thousand seven hundred & ninety five

of Robt. Fry & David Holdcroft two of the Witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded and on the
motion of Wm Southall the executor therein named who made oath thereto according to
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acknowledged their bonds in the patty of One thousand Dollars with condition
according to Law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due
form
