<sup>Ely Demoville</sup> Will <sup>of Virg<sup>a</sup></sup> do make & ordain this writing as & for my last will &  
testament.- Whereas I am entitled to one half of the crops made  
seured, or to be seured from the plantation in this County called  
"The Level" the present year, of which said plantation Peter  
Demoville is at present manager & is to be benefitted by the other  
half:- And being indebted to my son Temple E Demoville as well  
in pecuniary considerations, as for his filial affection & attention  
do give and bequeath to my said son, Temple E, all my right, title  
and interest in & to the one moiety of the crops aforesaid or the money  
arising from such sales thereof; upon condition that my said son  
Temple E, pay the expences of physicians for attending me since  
I came from Richmond, & whilst I remain with him.-

I witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my  
seal this 12<sup>th</sup> day of July One thousand eight hundred and nineteen  
Signed, Sealed published & declared by Elizabeth Demoville <sup>Seal</sup>  
the said Elizabeth Demoville as & for
