In the name of God Amen I Elizabeth Finch, of Charles City County being weak
of body but of a sound mind and Memory do make Ordain constitute and appoint this
my last will and testament in manner and form following. First I give and
bequeath unto the Children of my deceased son Henry Finch, namely Mary Truman, Martha
Annors, Frances Johnson, Elizabeth Mose Finch, William Finch Twenty Shillings
a piece to them and their Heirs forever to be paid by my Executors hereafter to be
Nominated. Secondly I Give and bequeath unto my two Daughters Frances Ann Binford
and Judith Garthright all the Real and Personal of my Estate to the real and Personal that
is to say Land and negroes and every other species of property that I may be possessed of to
be equally divided between them and their Heirs Lawfully begotten of their bodies forever
except my Right in the title that I give and bequeath unto Robert Binford to him
and his Heirs forever. Lastly I do appoint Robert Binford, William Baker and Fielding
Holland Executors to this my last will and Testament to see the same duly performed.

At a monthly court held for Charles City County at the Courthouse on Thursday the fifteenth
day of January 1807

The aforementioned last Will and Testament of Elizabeth Finch deceased was this day presented
in Court by Robert Binford one of the executors therein named and being proved by John Binford
and Robert Bradley two of the witnesses thereto ordered to be recorded and on the motion
of the said executor who made oath as the law directs and entered into bond with John
Binford and Jesse Grinstead his securities in the penalty of \$4000. Conditional according
to Law Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form liberty
reserved the other executors to join in the probat when they may think fit.
