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dollars current money per year during her natural life: the same to be paid unto her each year by my two sons Cornelius and Christopher Eymon or their heirs. - Item. - I give and bequeath unto my two sons Cornelius and Christopher Eymon all the rest and residue of my estate of every kind and description to be equally divided between them and to be enjoyed by them and their heirs forever. - And lastly I do nominate and appoint my son Cornelius Eymon executor to this my last will and testament revoking and disannulling all other wills heretofore made by me. - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this eighth day of December eighteen hundred and twelve.
