I leave my estate in my wifes hands for the purpose of raising my children and schooling them in the best way that she may be able; And lastly I appoint my friend Robert C. Hills my executor to put in force the above conditions of this my will. Given under my hand and seal the twenty-eighth day of April eighteen hundred and twenty three.
