In the name of God Amen I Littlebury Irlby being weak in body, but of sound mind and disposing Memory and conscious of the uncertainty of human life and desirous of disposing of what earthly goods it has pleased God to bless me with, to that end do make and ordain this my last will and testament revoking all others - that is to say - Item, I leave to my wife Sarah Irlby all my estate during her Widowhood for the purpose of raising my children, Consisting of Negroes Horses, Cattle, and hogs, together with crops and plantation utensils of every description - Item, My will and desire is that after the death or Marriage of my wife Sarah Irlby that my estate be equally divided among all my Children share and share alike - Item my will and desire is that there shall be no appraisement of my estate, nor that my wife whom I nominate my executrix and my son Anthony J. Irlby my executor be compelled to give security Dated and sealed the twenty ninth day of November one thousand eight hundred and ten
