In the name of God amen I Major Cole of the County of Charles
 City do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and
 form as follows, to wit: To my brother Squire Ambler and to my brother-in-law
 Justice Mingo (emancipated negro) I give and bequeath my wife Elizabeth
 Cole to be disposed of as they may think proper. Item, I give and bequeath
 unto my wife Elizabeth Cole all my estate of what nature or kind soever,
 after my just debts are paid. And lastly I constitute and appoint my aforesaid
 brother Squire Ambler and brother-in-law Justice Mingo, executors of this my
 last will and testament. In testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my
 hand and seal this 21st day April 1820.

At a Court held for Charles City County the 15th day of June 1820.—
 The aforesaid last will and testament of Major Cole deceased was presented
 in Court and proved by the oath of B. Dancy the only subscribing witness
 to the same, and ordered to be recorded. And at another Court held for the
 said County the 20th day of July following. On the motion of Justice Mingo one
 of the Executors in said Will named who made oath thereto according to
 law and with Major Bullifant and Robert Holdcroft his securities entered
 into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three hundred dollars
 conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted the said Justice for
 claiming a probate of said Will in due form.
