Item, I give and bequeath unto my wife Elizabeth Cole all my estate of what nature or kind soever, after my just debts are paid. And lastly I constitute and appoint my aforesaid brother Squire Ambler and brother-in-law Justice Minge, executors of this my last will and testament. In testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 21st day April 1820.
