In the name of God Amen: I Thomas Gannaway of the County of Charles City being sick (and weak in body but of sound mind and memory) do ordain constitute and appoint this my last Will and Testament revoking all other or former Wills heretofore made by me in manner and form following: First I Give to my friend Reuben Francis all my Estate both real and personal to him and his heirs for ever - Secondly and lastly I do appoint my friend Reuben Francis Executor to this my last Will and Testament to have the privilege of acting freely without being oblig'd to render security to the County Court or any other Court or person whatever. Given under my hand and seal this twentieth day of June one thousand eight hundred and sixteen

I request my executor hereafter named as soon as he possibly can with convenience to pay all my just debts for which purpose I subject all my Estate of every kind and direct that he will make an estimate of said debts & immediately after my decease sell & dispose of my household & kitchen furniture, stocks & provisions on hand (and such of my negroes (the female part) as he may think proper for the purpose aforesaid - I constitute & appoint my brother Peter Wilkinson executor of this my last will & testament & Guardian to my son William and as I have the fullest confidence in his integrity I request that the Court in which he qualifies in each or either of the capacities aforesaid may permit him to do so without giving Security
