In the name of God Amen I Joshua Tugua of Charles City being weak in body but of sound mind and memory do make and ordain this my last will and testament in form and manner following to wit my will and desire is that my colt, Sheep, a bed with such other things as my wife may claim, be sold to pay my just debts, the balance of my estate I leave in the hands of my dear wife as long as she lives and remains single, but then to be sold and equally divided among my children or their heirs that may then be living. I leave my estate in my wifes hands for the purpose of raising my children and schooling them in the best way that she may be able; And lastly I appoint my friend Robert C. Hills my executor to put in force the above conditions of this my will. Given under my hand and seal the twenty-eighth day of April eighteen hundred and twenty three.
