Richmond Finck's Will Charles City County and State of Virginia being in perfect health
mind and memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament, revoking and disannulling all other Wills heretofore made by me. Item its my Will and desire as I am called in requisition to go in the Army that if it should please God I should be either killed or owe a natural death, it is my wish and desire that my brother George S Finck heir my whole estate both real and personal and all estates that I may hereafter heir and if it should so happen that my brother George S Finck should owe or be killed during this expedition which we are now engaged in it is my Will and desire that my brother Alfred Finck heir my whole estate and estates which I may hereafter heir, after in either case my just debts be paid, Lastly I nominate and appoint my brother Henry Finck my executor to this my last Will and Testament. In Testimony whereof I have here set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty third day of August, 1814
