Robt. Foy's
Will

In the name of God Amen I Robert Foy of the County of Charles City and Parish
of Westover being sick and Weak but of perfect mind and Memory and calling to mind the un-
certainty of this life and that all men must Yeeld to Death when it pleaseth the great
disposer of all things to call, do ~~Make~~ this to be my last will and Testament in Manner
viz first I recommend my soul to God who gave it me and hope for a forgiveness of all my
sins through the merits of a braced saviour and as for my ~~Wortely~~ worldly goods as it
has pleased Almighty God to lend me I give and bequeath in the manner following
to wit - Here my will and desire is that all my Just Debts be paid - Then I give
unto my loving Wife Elizabeth Foy all my Estate both real and personall to her to dispose
of as she may think proper lastly I constitute and appoint my aforesaid Wife Elizabeth
Executrix of this my Last will and Testament without her being Obliged to give
security for her Executrix ship revoking all others heretofore made in
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this seventh day

of October one thousand eight hundred and one

At a Monthly Court held for Charles City County at the Courthouse on Thursday the 15th July 1802. — The aforesaid last will and testament of Robert Fry ^{decd} was presented in Court by Elizabeth Fry the executrix therein named and being proved by the Oaths of Robert Chandler one of the Witnesses ~~therein~~ ordered to be recorded and on the Motion of the said Elizabeth who made Oath as the Law directs and entered into Bond with Nathaniel Bowles, William Parish and Joseph Varden Jun^r her securities in the penalty of four Thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law Certificate is granted her for obtaining a probat thereof in due form.
