I will to my mother Bosley Bradley of Prince Edward County during her natural life Naming a negra woman and Ned a black Smell, together with a set of Smiths tools. It is my will and desire that the above named Naming and Ned shall go to my brother Jope Bradley and his heirs forever at my mother's decease. I will to my brother Jope one dozen tea spoons eight table spoons, a bell metal skillet, and my horse bridle and saddle to him and his heirs forever. It is my will and desire that the balance of my estate not already given away shall be sold and all my just debts paid out of the proceeds. It is my will and desire that the remainder and residue of my estate after paying my just debts, together with all and singular his just debts now due to me shall be equally divided between my sisters Elizabeth and Susan Bradley to them and their heirs forever I constitute and appoint Jope Bradley and John Stagg executors to this my last will and testament In witness whereof I set my hand and seal this 9th day of April one thousand eight hundred and fourteen.

At a Court held for Charles City County at the Courthouse the 16 day of June 1814 The aforesaid last will and testament of Thomas Bradley deceased was proved by the oath of Joshua Knibb a witness to the same. And at another court held for said County as aforesaid the 21st day of July following the said will was further proved by the oath of Mary Bradley another witness to the same and Ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of Jope Bradley one of the executors therein named who made oath thereto according to law and together with William Bradley and Thomas Stagg his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twenty four hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs, Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form. Liberty reserved to the other executor to join in said probate when he shall think fit
