And find the Ex^r indebted to the estate of Jeffery Gilliam the sum of Seven hundred two dollars twenty cents. provided Bob a negro man charged in the acct^s of sales be the property of Jeffery Gilliam's estate. But if Bob should not be the property of the said Jeffery Gilliam then the executor will be indebted to the said estate the sum of three hundred thirty seven dollars twenty cents. Given under our hands this 21st day of August one Thousand eight hundred and twenty.
