last the said tract of Land & Plantation I give to my said two sons
Lewis Lefevre & Francis Lefevre & their Heirs forever

Item I give & bequeath unto my Wife Sarah Lefevre & my two
Daughters Susanna Lefevre & Jane Lefevre all the remainder
of my Estate to be equally divided amongst them Share & Share
alike And it is my will & desire that my two Daughters
Susanna & Jane may have their portions of the ^{same} remainder
of my Estate when they are married or ~~or~~ come to the age of twenty
one years to themselves their Heirs forever & my Wife Sarah to enjoy
her part of my Estate during Life

And Lastly I do appoint & constitute ^{my} William Martin
& Daniel Frabus to be the Executors of this ^{my last} Will & Testament
revoking all former Wills by me made
