

Will: In the Name of God amen I the said ^{Cheslerfield County, Virginia, 1780 to 1800} ^{www.virginiapioneers.net} ~~Charles~~ ^{Charles} Cogbitt of Charlesfield County
of sound mind and memory, thanks be to God for the same I do make
and ordain this my last Will and Testament in the Manner and
form as followeth.

I give devise and bequeath unto my son Charles Christian Cogbitt and
to his Heirs and Assigns forever the Land in Charlesfield County where
I now live containing about three hundred and ten Acres more or less
but in case the said Charles Christian Cogbitt shall depart this
Life under the Age of twenty one years old then and in that case
my Will and bequest is and I will it so to be for the said Land
to be equally divided between my four Children to wit, Thomas
Cogbitt, Sally Cogbitt Suckey Stith Cogbitt and Polly Squire
Cogbitt and their respective Heirs

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my two Children that I had
by my first Wife to wit Thomas Cogbitt and Fanny Cogbitt
and to their respective Heirs and to be equally divided between
them eight Negroes, named Figgie, Doll, Polly, Nancy,
Jack, Abner, Silas and Eliza and their future Increase

I give and devise unto my Son Thomas Cogbill one hundred
Pounds, to be paid unto him out of the Joint Money collected
from the Sale of the Lands, that I have already agreed to sell
unto Thomas Cogbill, Michael Wells & George Vaden, which
said Land I do give unto the said Thomas Cogbill, Michael Wells
and George Vaden and to their respective Heirs whomsoever
they pay or secure the Payment thereof and to be divided between
them according to the Lines already made and I do also authorize
my Executors hereafter named or either of them to execute
Deeds of Conveyance for the same when the Payments are
secured, and in Case the said Thomas Cogbill should depart this
Life under Age then and in that Case I desire and will it so to
be for the said one hundred Pounds to be equally divided between
my four young Children and their Heirs respectively.

Item I give devise and bequeath all the Remainder & Residue of my
Estate not above mentioned or given away unto my loving
Wife Lucy Cogbill, and my three young Daughters Sally Cogbill

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shewing that he hath and Polly Sowers Cogbill and their
Heirs respectively to be equally divided between them as
the said Children respectively come of Age or mar-
ries and for my Wife to have her fifth Part thereof
on the finishing the bequest after my Death in lieu
of her Power of or in my whole Estate. I desire
that my Estate be not appraised but for my Executors
to keep an Inventory thereof - And I do nominate, con-
stitute and appoint my Brother Jesse Cogbill and my
Nephew Edw.^d Goode Executors of this my last Will &
Testament. In Witness whereof I the said Charles
Cogbill have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this
twenty fifth Day of September 1789
