Willis of and now doing, make this my last will and testament
and ordain this my last will and testament to be witnessed and
form as follows:

I give devise and bequeath unto my dear daughter Elizabeth Capell all
to her Heirs and Assigns forever the land in Chesterfield County where
I now live containing about three hundred and ten acres more or less
but so soon the said Charles Christian Capell shall depart his
life under the age of twenty one years old then and in that case
my Will goes to whom so ever I will it so to be for the residue
to be equally divided between my four children to wit, Thomas
Capell, Sally Capell, Lucy Stitt Capell and Polly Sownd
Capell and their respective Heirs

Item I gave devise and bequeath unto my two children that I had
by my first wife to wit Thomas Capell and Fanny Capell
and to their respective Heirs and to be equally divided between
them eight Negroes, named Buggsy, Dole, Betsy, Nancy,
Jack, John, Sally and Elsey and their future increase.

Item I give and devise unto my son Thomas Logbill one hundred
Pounds, to be paid unto him out of the first Money collected
from the Sale of the Lands, that I have already agreed to sell
unto Thomas Logbill, Michael Wells & George Tatton, which
said Land I do give unto the said Thomas Logbill, Michael Wells
and George Tatton and to their respective Heirs whomsoever
they pay or receive the Payment thereof and to be divided between
them according to the Sines already made and I do also authorise
my Executors hereafter named or either of them to execute
Deeds of Conveyance for the same when the payments are
secured, and in case the said Thomas Logbill should depart this
Life under age then and in that case I desire and will it so to
be for the said one hundred Pounds to be equally divided between
my four young Children and their Heirs respectively.

Item I give devise and bequeath all the Remainder & Possession of my
Estate not above mentioned or going away unto my loving
Wife Lucy Logbill, and my three young Daughters before before

This my last Will and Testament I make and publish this
the sixtth Children and property and of my wife and
me and for my wife to have her full Right
on the finishing her life after my Death
of her Drawing or in my death ~~and~~ I desire
that my Estate be not appraised before my Death
to keep an Inventory there^t - And I do nominate an
Executor and appoint my Brother John Logbill and my
Stephan Edw^r Goode Executors of this my last Will &
