I give & bequeath unto the children of my Daughter Elizabeth
the Mann with their increase which I formerly lent her to be equally divided
between them when the eldest shall come to legal age

I give & bequeath unto my son Thomas Perkins & to him & his heirs
forever the Negroes & other Estate formerly lent him also two Negroes named
Peter & John the Household Furniture now in my Possession & also one grey
Horse & one white Mare

I give & bequeath unto my son Lewis Perkins & to him & his heirs
forever the Land & Plantations in Chesterfield ^{County} where he now lives containing
three hundred & ninety Acres & the Negroes & other Estate formerly lent him
& also two Negroes named, Belley & Agg

I give & bequeath unto my grandson Edmund Perkins & to him & his heirs
his Horse four or one grey Mare

Here I give & bequeath unto my grandson Edward Haskins the sum
his share for one grey Mare

Here I give & bequeath unto my son John Haskins & his wife
for ever ten Negroes Vizt. Tommy, Dances, Harry, Jude, Long, Hannah, Tony
I am sure by States all the remainder part of my Estate not before mentioned
And lastly I do constitute & appoint my sons Edward Haskins &
John Haskins Executors to this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking
all other Wills by me heretofore made In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this seventh Day of June one thousand
seven hundred & eighty one.
