Widowhood and after her death or marriage the said Real
or residue of my estate real or personal I give and bequeath

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Vaden to them and their heirs forever to be equally divided
amongst them. Lastly I do nominate constitute and appoint
my Brother George Vaden my Executor of this my last
will and Testament hereby revoking and making void all
other and former wills by me heretofore made In
Witness whereof I have herunto set my hand and seal
this fourth Day of July in the year of our Lord one
Thousand seven hundred and ninety two
