and all my notes one half and half to him and his heirs forever

I give one half and Furniture to Dolley Farmer the daughter of Thomas
Farmer Son and one ring of Gold to her and her heirs forever
And the rest of my estate that I have not given away I give to

my estate should not be appraised Truly I appoint Thomas Thomas my
my executor and Thomas Thomas one of the my last Will and Testament
nothing all former Wills by me made as writing my hand and Seal this
Tenth day of October one thousand Seven hundred and eighty Six
