Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Natharine Walker one cow to her, her
heirs and assigns forever

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Beade one shilling Sterling
to her her heirs and assigns forever //

Item All the remainder part of my estate both real and personal I leave unto
my wife Elizabeth Folkes during her natural life, and after my said
wife decease I give to be equally divided between my two sons John and
Beater Folkes all the negroes stock of horses cattle ~~and~~ sheep and
household and kitchen furniture ~~and~~ that my wife should leave at
her death then each ones part severally as it is divided between I give
and bequeath unto them their heirs and assigns forever

The plantation I now live on consisting of by estimation three hundred
and twenty five acres be the same more or less after my wife's decease
I give to be divided between my two sons Edward and Beater Folkes
in manner and form as follows beginning at Lees River at a

to the edge of the high land thence along the edge of the high land to an old
tree standing on the head of a flat known by the name of the white gum
from thence to a white oak standing on the Run known by the name of the gum
Spring Run from thence to a large black gum standing below by my son
Edward's house, and from thence to be equally divided in half as far as to
my house line. The upper half which I now live in leaving to John Lyons &
Lyons and beneath unto my son Charles Folkes to him his heirs assigns forever.
The other half of my land leaving to Peter Land Lyon to my son Edward Folkes
to him his heirs and assigns forever. I also appoint and ordain my two sons
John and Charles Folkes Executors and my wife Elizabeth Folkes Executrix to
this my last Will and Testament during my whole may not be appraised
