I give & bequeath to my good son John Archer Son of John Archer one Negro
named Phillis to him & to his Heirs forever.

I give & bequeath to James Throat one stud Horse named Mercury to
him

I give & bequeath to James Throck one sixth of the House named Albemarle &
to his Heirs forever

All the residue of my Estate including Lands Slaves & every other kind
of Property whatsoever after paying my Just Debts & funeral Expenses
I give to be equally divided between my three Sisters vizt Lucy, Susan & Mary
Gardner & Betty & their Heirs forever

Lastly I do nominate & appoint James Throck & Benjamin Branch Just. Exrs
of this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my

hand & seal this twentieth Day of March 1783
