formerly lived on to him his Heirs & Assigns forever when he arrives to the age of
twenty one years shall have five hundred pounds Cash

Item I give & bequeath to my son Henry Farmer the Land & Plantation that I

his heirs & assigns forever

I then give & bequeath to my Daughter Martha Lewis one negro woman
called Doll at the Death of my Wife during her natural Life to her heirs

I then give & bequeath to my son Elam Feamer all that is now in his possession
except a negro fellow called Bratcher at the Division of my Estate he & his heirs
& divided with the rest of the Negroes aforesaid

I then give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary Russell one Negroe called Nancy
during her natural Life then to be equally divided amongst her Children to them &
their heirs & assigns forever

I then give & bequeath to my Daughter Judith Russell one Negroe called
Sheper during her natural Life then to be equally divided amongst her Children
to them their heirs & assigns forever

I then give & bequeath to my Daughter Rhoda Bales one Negroe called Peter during her

during her natural Life then she & her increase to be equally divided amongst her
Children if any if not amongst all my Sons

And I bequeath to my other two Daughters Sally Farmer & Ruth Farmer
And I bequeath a horse & half if they do not want I give they or either of them their part is
to equally divided amongst my sons

Item my Will & Desire is that all my stock of Horses cattle Hogs & sheep & the
Household & Kitchen Furniture to equally divided amongst my Wife & two sons
Lodwick Farmer & Henry Farmer my Wife to have her part during her Widowhood & then
to be divided to all my sons

Item my Will & Desire is that all my whole Estate both real & personal that is not already
given away to be equally divided amongst my three sons To Wit Elam Farmer Henry
Farmer & Lodwick Farmer when Lodwick shall arrive ^{the age of} ~~to~~ twenty one years of age by any
three Men that they shall choose

Item I give & bequeath to my son Henry Farmer at the Death or Marriage of my

of this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand &
affixed my seal this thirtieth ^{day} of November one thousand seven hundred & eighty
