equally divided between my two sons Abell & Henry Moore.

I give unto my son Abell Moore one feather Bed and one cow & calf after the death of my wife to him and his heirs for ever

I give unto my son Abell Moore and my six daughters Frances Blankenship (wife of George Blankenship) Susanah Moore Elizabeth Moore Phoebe Moore Sarah Moore and Mary Moore after the death of my

wife Elizabeth Moore all the residue of my estate not yet given away to be equally divided between them at the death of my wife the if any of them die before the division then and in that case to be equally divided between the survivors to them and to their heirs forever

I desire that my Estate be not appraised.

I constitute my friend Thomas Barfoot and my friend Archer Traylor Executors of this my last will and testament, in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 7th day of October 1792.
