Chesterfield County, Virginia Wills 1705 to 1800
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widow of the county of Chesterfield being of sound and perfect mind
and memory do make and constitute this my last Will and testament
in manner and form following:

I give to my daughter Mary Linncon and her husband one Shilling
Specie which is my will and intention shall cut off and deprive
Linncon and wife from any pretension or claim he or She may
have against my estate

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah English and her husband one
Shilling Specie and no more for the purpose mentioned in the preceeding clause

I give to my daughter Martha Wilson wife of Lodwick Wilson a young
Red Kipper

I give and bequeath to my grand daughters Polly Andrews a bed and
furniture and the household furniture and to my Grandson Adam Andrews a gun
All the rest of my estate not above mentioned I give and bequeath to my Daughter

Impromus I give to my daughter Mary Luricoon and her husband one Shilling

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Specie which is my will and intention shall cutt off and deprive so
Dunmore and wife from any pretention or claim he or She may
have against my estate

Item I give and bequeath to my Daw Sarah English and her husband one
Shilling Specie and no more for the purposes mentioned on the preceeding clause

Item I give to my daughter Martha Wilson wife of Lodwick Wilson a young
Nes Keiper

Item I give and bequeath to my Grand daughters Polly Andrews a bed and
furniture and the household furniture and to my Grandson Adam Andrew a gun
All the rest of my estate not above mentioned I give and bequeath to my Daw
Mason Andrews to her and her heirs forever and so declare this to be my
last will and testament and no other Intestimony whereof I have hereto affixed
my hand and Seal this Twentieth day of August 1784
