I give and bequeath unto my brother Jacob Ashurst one half the money the John Ferras and William Trabue is now owing of me for which I have their bond for I give and bequeath to my brother Henry Ashurst all the rest of my estate both personal and singular and I do hereby acknowledge this to be my last Will and testament In witness whereof

I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the twenty fifth day of
November in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand Seven hun-
dred and eighty four
