this my last will and Testament. in manner and form following, viz

discretion of my executor hereafter mentioned. hoping for pardon of all
my sins through the merits of Jesus Christ our Lord and my good
state which it hath pleased God to bless me with. I bestow

Item I give unto Joseph Smith son of Childers Smith one negro
plantation whereon I now live. and I give unto and I give
the said Childers Smith to have the use of the land and negro
his son Joseph Smith comes to the age of twenty five years then
he to possess and enjoy the said land and negro for his life
forever.

Item I give unto Childers Smith son of Childers Smith one negro
boy named Hannah to be in the use of his father till he comes to the
age of twenty five years then to possess and enjoy the same to him and his
heirs forever.

Item I give unto Littleberry Smith one negro boy named Jimmy to be
delivered to him at the age of twenty one to possess and enjoy for him and his
heirs forever.

Item all the me land dole and tenement houses shall be paid I over all the

delivered to him at the age of twenty one to possess & enjoy to him and his
heirs forever

Alm. after my just debts and funeral charges shall be paid I give all the
of my estate unto Thuders Smith senr. as stock, Cattle, hogs, horses, household
goods of all kinds, out debts, and every part and parcel thereof without
reserve to him and his heirs forever.

Alm. I appoint my friend Thuders Smith senr. whole and sole executor
of my last will and Testament making, annulling and making
void all other wills or Testaments verbal or written before made by me
and do ratify and confirm this to be my last will and Testament, and
In more proof whereof I have hereunto set my hand and fixed my seal
this twenty ninth day of December one thousand seven hundred and
