Chesterfield County, Virginia Wills 1785 to 1800
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In the name of God amen I George Cogbill of
Chesterfield County being of sound mind and memory Thanks be to
God for the same I do make and ordain this my last will and testa-
ment in the manner and form as followeth

I give devise and bequeath unto my son John Cogbill and to his heirs
and assigns forever two negroes named Dick and Frank

I give devise and bequeath unto my son Charles Cogbill and to his heirs
and assigns forever one negro woman named Effie

I give devise and bequeath unto my son Jesse Cogbill and to his heirs
and assigns forever three negroes named Ned John and Lucy

I Give and bequeath unto each of my ^{children} John Jackson and
Mary Jackson twenty pounds. These each to be paid to their father by John
Jackson for the use of the said John and Mary Jackson, and in case either of
the said John or Mary Jackson should die under age or unmarried, then
and in that case for the surviving child to have the others part, but should
both the said children die under age or unmarried then and in that case,
for my two grandsons Thomas Nelson Cogbill and George Washington Cogbill
to have the said forty pounds equally ^{divided} between them and their heirs.

I Give devise and bequeath unto my two sons Jesse Cogbill and John Cogbill
all the remainder and residue of my estate of every kind both real and
personal to be equally divided between the said Jesse Cogbill and John Cogbill
and their respective heirs - I advise that my estate be not appraised

and their respective heirs. I desire that my estate be not appraised

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and my debts as, and I will it so to be for what debts I may owe to be paid
by my sons Charles Cogbill, John Cogbill, and Jesse Cogbill equally in propor-
tion to what I have given them in this my last will and testament.

And I do hereby constitute ordain and appoint my three Sons Charles Cogbill
John Cogbill and Jesse Cogbill Executors of this my last will and Testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal
this Twentieth day of February one thousand Seven hundred and eighty
