Memory & make it certain that my last Will & Testament be disposed of all my worldly
Goods in manner & form Viz.

Impressus. The First I desire that all my lawful Debts shall be paid & for me to be
buried in a christian like & decent manner

Item I give five pounds to George ^{James} ~~James~~ to be applied to his schooling

Item I give two pounds to Nancy Pickett Daughter of Henry Pickett to be ap-
plied to her schooling

Item all the rest of my Estate to be divided, two and the said George James

& Mary Puckett as they come of Age I do will & appoint
 Mary Puckett & Mary my Executor to this my last Will & Testament among
 my heirs my next of kin Given under my Hand & seal this 28th day
 of September 1778
