and Memory, do make and declare this to be my last will
and Testament in manner hereinafter following My
I give unto my loving ^{Wife} Mary West during her natural
Life my Land and Plantation whereon I now live also
my two Negroes George and Isaac, Stock of Horses
Sheep and Hogs, House Hold Furniture and Plantations
Utensils, except such part of my Negroes George and
Isaac, Stock of Horses, Cattle, Sheep and Hogs, house hold
Furniture and Plantations Utensils as is hereinafter
otherwise disposed of

I am I give unto my Son John Thomas West's two Children
William West, and John West the Plantation
I now live after the Death of my Wife Mary West
to them and their Heirs forever.

Item I give unto my Wife Mary West my two Negroes George
and Isaac to her and to her Heirs forever.

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I Turned over one young Horse my small Gun whensoever
he marries or after the Death of my Wife Mary West, to
him and to his heirs forever.

Item I give unto my three Children Littleberry West, Mary
Belcher, & Peter Smith after the death of my wife
Mary West the residue of my Estate not yet given
away to be equally divided between them, to them and
to their heirs forever.

Item. It is my Desire that my Estate be not appraised

Item I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Little-
berry West Executor and my Wife Mary West Executrix
of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my Hand and affixed my Seal this
19th Day of September 1789
