feather Bed & Furniture

I give my Desire is that if either of my sons die without Heirs that then their Estate or Legacy
return to the Heirs at law

I give unto my Daughter Nancy Grant & to her Heirs one Negro Boy named John

I give unto my Daughter Fidelity Yates to her Heirs one feather Bed & Furniture in
Board & half

I give unto my Daughter Edith Grant to her Heirs one feather Bed & Furniture

I give unto my living Wife Edith Grant one Negro woman named Orla & her
increase & my Stock of all kinds to with & dispose of as she pleaseth I leave unto my Wife & her
during her natural Life the Plantation whereon I now live with one hundred Acres of Land
with all my Household Goods & Tools of all kinds thereunto belonging I leave unto my Wife
three Negroes Pious Daniel & Gideon till the Boys comes of age & that there be no

 my last Will & Testament and it is hereby confirmed that my
 To Wills whereof I have made out my hand & seal the thirtieth
 of February one thousand seven hundred & eighty two
