Item I give & bequeath to my son John two Negroes named Nell & her child named Kate & all the increase they may ever have to him & his heirs forever

Item I give & bequeath to my son Elisha one negroe Woman named Sarah & her increase to him & his heirs forever

Item I give my son Valentine one negroe man named Ned to him & his heirs forever

Item I give my Daughter Judith & all the Labour of negroe women named Fanny & all her increase during the Term of her natural Life & from & after her decease I give the said Natch & her children if any to be equally divided between the Children of my said Daughter should share alike

Item I give my son Archibald one negroe Boy named Sam to him & his heirs forever

Item I give my son David two negroes named Jolly & Mink with all the
increase they may ever have together with one hundred acres of land to be taken off from the
upper part of the tract. Land I now live on to him & his heirs forever

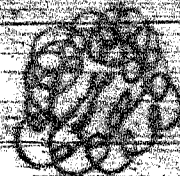
I have given my son Moll & Luce two Negroes named Phill & Dido & their increase together with
