In the name of God amen. I Henry Turpin late of the County of Chesterfield
& Manchester Parish on this eighteenth Day of October in the year of our Lord Christ
thousand seven hundred ~~and~~ eighty two do make full & certain this my last
& Testament as shall hereafter direct

I here give & bequeath unto my Daughter Francis Stanton my two Negroes Kate &
Fillis with the increase of the said Negroes to her & her Heirs forever

I here give & bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Turpin my two Negroes a boy named
Bristol & a girl Phoebe with the increase of the said Negroes half her Heirs forever

I here give & bequeath unto my son Joseph Turpin my two Negroes a man
Peter & a girl Nancy with the increase of the said Negroes to him & his Heirs forever

I here give & bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Turpin my two Negroes Patsy &
Job Selove with the increase of the said Negroes to her & her Heirs forever

and my good father David Turpin my son & then called Daniels with a good house & garden
and house & garden

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Obadiah Turpin all my Land on the west side my house
from the lower line up the brook to Backons Spring Branch then up the side to the line
with my two Negroes & then I give & bequeath unto the increase of the said Negroes with my good
father's Bed & Furniture to him & his Heirs forever

Item I give & bequeath unto my son George Turpin my two Negroes by David & get & give
with the increase of the said Negroes to him & his Heirs forever one good Horse & saddle one
good father's Bed & Furniture two barrels below four head of Sheep Two Swine & Pigs
and bequeath

Item I give unto my Wife Sarah Turpin my four Negroes Men John Man & three women Hannah
& get & give with their increase to her & her Heirs forever

Item I give & bequeath unto my son George & Jeremiah Turpin all my Land & Possession at
Antietam Long Lane in Chesterfield County Virginia Place beginning at the Place called
Chesterfield County Wills 1774 to 1785

I give & bequeath unto my two sons ^{Turpin} George & Jeremiah Turpin all my Land & Possession at
Buckingham & my Land in Chesterfield County called Burgess Place beginning at the Place called
the old Licking Place & to full full on Francis Chatham's Line for two hundred acres to be
equally divided between them at the time of George Turpin's being twenty one years old to
them & their Heirs forever

I give & bequeath unto my son Henry Turpin my Land & Plantation whereon I now live
with all my Land adjoining not before mentioned or given away but my Wife Anne Turpin
to have the Use of the said Plantation with ^{him} during her natural Life then to him & his Heirs forever

I give & bequeath unto my two sons Jeremiah Turpin & Henry Turpin all my Negroes not
before mentioned or given away with their increase to be equally divided between them when
Jeremiah Turpin is twenty years old to them & their Heirs forever

I give & bequeath unto my son ^{Jeremiah} Jeremiah Turpin all my Land & Possession at
Buckingham & my Land in Chesterfield County called Burgess Place beginning at the Place called
the old Licking Place & to full full on Francis Chatham's Line for two hundred acres to be
equally divided between them at the time of George Turpin's being twenty one years old to
them & their Heirs forever

to be paid to my wife & her heirs forever
and to my wife & her heirs forever
& then to my wife & her heirs forever

And lastly I do hereby appoint my wife & her heirs
Obadiah Turpin & the children of Turpin heirs of this my last Will & Testament
& making void all Wills heretofore made declaring this & no other. In Witness whereof
