Winfree's

Wife I Henry Winfree of Chesterfield County being
Very Sick and weak in body but sound memory in mind thank be to God for the
same do make and constitute and ordain that my last Will and Testament as followeth

Item My desire is that as much of land be sold on the town end of my land where on I
live by my Executors as will pay all my just debts.

Item I leave in my life as a widow's share for the maintenance of my children
I leave to my wife Betty Winfree the remainder of my land and after my

Wife's death or marriage my will is that the land be equally divided between my
sons Henry Winfree and David Winfree to them and their heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my three daughters viz. Judith Parley Winfree Polly

I give & Bequeath unto my daughter Martha Louisa three Negroes namely Sam
Frank & Honey to her her heirs & Assigns forever but if my aforesaid daughter
Martha should Decease before married or of lawfull age then my Will is that
