Item my will is that my Negro Girl Betty and my negro boy David should be sold to pay my debts if any money left my will is that it should be put to the use of all my family.

Item I give unto my beloved wife Merian Jackson one Negro Man named Tom during her single life and then to be equally divided amongst all my children Coleman Jackson Millington Jackson and Sarah Jackson. Item I also give unto my beloved wife Merian Jackson all my kitchen and Household furniture during her single life and then to be equally divided among all my children Coleman Millington and Sarah all the residue of my estate that is not heretofore mentioned in this my last

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I also give unto my beloved wife Miriam Jackson all my kitchen
and household furniture during her single life and then to be equally

divided among all my children Coleman Millington and Sarah all
the residue of my estate that is not heretofore mentioned in this my last
will and Testament I leave to the discretion of my executors to
dispose of as they may think proper and the money to be put to the
use of all my family last of all I do constitute and appoint my
