And I do hereby revoke demand and make void all former
acknowledgments of my last Will and Testament.

I now I send unto my true & well beloved Wife the rest of my Lands & Tenements & all the rest of my Estate during her life & after her Death my Land I leave to her to be equally divided between Pierce Barbours & Lodwick Barbours & I give Lodwick to have the Plantation where I live & the rest of the Estate to be equally divided among these persons here mentioned Viz. John Barbours Pierce Barbours Lodwick Barbours Nathan Barbours the Son of John Barbours & my two Daughters Elizabeth Barbours & Mary Barbours to which said Estate I give to them & their Heirs forever

And lastly I nominate & appoint Abigail Barbours Pierce Barbours & Francis Barbours Executors to this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this twenty second Day of Nov
