to first Plough that makes in his fence then up the Plough to the head then
a straight line to Cold branch also one bay mare, but not the fold that the
is of fould with and if he dies without a heir lawfully begotten of his body to
go to his brother John Hudson Junr

Then I give to my son Samuel Hudson the remainder part of my land, and one

Also I give and bequeath to my son ~~William~~ ^{John} Hudson part of my land over the
branch joining on parishes branch to William Brooks line then along his line
to point Plough that makes in his fence then up the Plough to the head then
a straight line to old branch also one bay mare, but not the foal that she
is of fault with one of her ears without a hurt lawfully begotten of her body to
go to his brother John Hudson Junr

Then I give to my son ~~Isaac~~ ^{Isaac} Hudson the remainder part of my land, and one
young bay horse.

Also to my son ~~Isaac~~ ^{Isaac} Hudson the foal that the abovementioned mare is of fault

Then I give to my daughter Winifred one good feather Bed

Then I give to my daughter Marny one good feather bed

Then the rest of my estate to be equally divided among all my children

Also I leave William Brooks and James Evans and my son John Hudson

my Executors to act to their discretion as witness my hand and seal this
