Sussex County do make & appoint this my last Will &

Testaments in manuscript form following

First my Will is all my Estate Estate & Funeral expenses be
paid for

I Give my Son, ^{John} Rowlett my tract of Land, known by the
name of "Kinteprock" it being the place he now lives at to have & his
Heirs forever Also four Negroes named Mingo, Pullen, Sam
& Ned together with the stock of Horses & cattle & Sheep that
is on the said Plantation.

Item I leave my Son William Rowlett the Plantation where he
now lives during his Natural Life & after Betty's Death or Marriages &
then to come to the said Son

name of Wentworth it being the place he now lives at to him & his
therefore also four Negroes named George, Peter, John
& Ned together with the stock of Horses & cattle Sheep & Hogs that
is on the said Plantation.

I Item I leave my son Williams now at the Plantation where he
now lives during his Mother's & Sister Betty's Death or Marriages &
then to remove to the ^{Place} where I now live

I Item I give my Daughter Frances Gell one Feather Bed &
Furniture

I Item I desire that my Daughter Phebe Setters should have a
part of my cattle & I desire that Daniel Patterson should have the
estate fifteen pounds ten Shillings that I lent him

I Item I give my Daughter Betty Rawlett one Feather Bed

I give my daughter Mary Dutton and brother David Dutton of
Virginia but called Sarah to her ^{1/2} share in part for the whole
estate, she may have part of my stock of cattle as much as she
I give my grand son Rowlett with twenty pounds current
money

I give my grand son John Rowlett son of William Rowlett
this plantation where I now live ~~at~~ after his Father's death be-
come Father Beal

I give my grand son John Rowlett son of George Rowlett the plantation
which is called Stony Creek after my son William Rowlett who has
now been where I now live

I give my dear beloved wife Phoebe Rowlett the land she has

which is called Storey built after my son William Rowlett who has
now been where I now live

Now I give ^{my} Dearest beloved Wife Phoebe Rowlett the use of the place
tion I now live on during her Widowhood & three Negroes viz. Ned
Peg & Mary Jane Feather Bed & Furniture after ~~her~~ ^{her} decease to be equally
divided among all my Children except John Rowlett & Mary Jane
Now my desire is that my Wife make her first choice of Bed as my dear
Frances Gill was my Daughter Mary Jane & my Daughter Mary
& my grand son John Rowlett Son of William Rowlett next & I desire
that my grand son John Paterson find ~~his~~ ^{his} ~~provision~~ ^{provision} ~~Guaranty~~ ^{Guaranty} Money
- Also I give unto my grand son William Deaton for provision
Guaranty Money

Now my will & desire is all the rest of my Estate
you may shall be equally divided between my Wife &
Children hereafter named my Son George Willmott my
Daughters Frances Betty Thebo

Lastly I appoint my Brother Thomas Rowlett my Son George
& my Son in law James Gibb Executors to this my last Will
~~Testament~~ In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & Seal this second Day of November 1774

My Will & desire is that my Estate may not be ap-
praised or inventoried
