Rachel & Mary my Daughters do live on it during their ^{own} Marriages & no
longer also all the Stock of all kinds Except my Mares

Here I give my Daughter Rachel Fifty one feather Beds & Furniture

Here I give my Daughter Mary Fifty one feather Beds & Furniture also one
Mare called Felt

Here I give the rest & residue of my Estate ^{after the debts} to be equally divided
between my ^{two} Daughters Rachel & Mary after the death of her Mother

Lastly I appoint my Son Iepo Stiles Executor of this my last Will & Testament
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the 20th Day of April 1770
