Inherit everlasting life and my body I commit to earth to be decently
buried at the discretion of my executors hereafter named and as
touching the disposition of all such temporal estate as it hath
pleased God to bestow upon me I give and dispose as follows

Item I give the use of my four Lots lying in Burmuda
hundred Town numbered eighteen, seventeen, thirty one, thirty two
also give my loving wife the use of all my whole estate (viz) negroes,
household stuff and furniture

Imprimus I give the use of my four Lots lying in Burmuda
hundred Town numbered eighteen, seventeen, thirty one, thirty two.
also, give my loving wife the use of all my whole estate (viz) negroes,
horses, cattle, hogs, sheep and &c. during her life. I also give my loving
wife one negroe boy named Neptune to her and his heirs forever, and
at her death the negroes not given away I desire shall be equally divided
one half she may dispose of as she thinks proper and the other half
I give to be equally divided between my brother Edward Worsham and
my sister Mary Wilkinson. all the rest of my estate goods and chattels
chattels whatsoever I give to my loving wife forever. Now knowing
wills by me made do ordain this to be my last will and testament and
do constitute and appoint my Friends Peter Epes, my Loving wife
and John Worsham my whole and sole Executors. In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 25 November 1765.
