Item I give to my son I give Taylor three Negroes Viz one Negro woman named Muriel
& her Child named Muriel as also one Negro woman named Amy which he hath in his
possession to him & his Heirs forever

Item I give to my Daughter Lou with the Rent one son & half to her & her Heirs

Item I give to my son I give Taylor one son & half to her & her Heirs

I give to him & his Heirs forever

I give to my Daughter Lot comth Berit one son & half to her & her Heirs

I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Jackson one Negro girl named Frank now in her

possession also one son & half to her & her Heirs forever

I give to my grand son Arthur Burton one Negro girl named Lucy when he shall
attain to the age twenty one Years & if my said grand^{son} should die before he should come to the
a^d age of twenty one Years that then my son Arthur Taylor should pay of the said Negro Lucy
I also further give to my said grand son a Bed & Furniture also twenty pounds Current
Money of this Commonwealth in the same manner as I give the said Negro girl Lucy when

& his Heirs forever

I give to my son Arthur Taylor all my Land on the County of Wharfedale as also
the rest of my Estate not yet given away both Negroes & other Estates that I possess with what I have
lent to my said Wife Elizabeth Taylor after her Death I give the same to my son Arthur

Chapter 1. In the Name of the Father

Know my Will is that my Estate should be ^{well} disposed

Item I constitute & appoint my son, John Taylor & my Friend, Thomas Harrison,
my sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament revoking all other Wills by me made
In Witness whereof I have set my hand & affixed my seal this tenth day of September 1777
