I also give to my son Mackey & to his Heirs forever one young black Horse also one feather
Bed & Furniture also the one half of my negro fellow Ague

the remainder part of the tract of Land whereon I now live which I have not already
given away lying on the south side of the Road from Jones Bridge to John Clarke
I also give to my son Mackay & to his Heirs forever one young black Horse also one feather
Bed & Furniture also the one half of my negro fellow Roger

I am I give & bequeath unto Martha Bury one feather Bed & Furniture known by the
name of my Bed

I am I give & bequeath unto Samuel Bury son of Martha Bury six pounds current
Money

I am I give & bequeath unto William Bury son of Martha Bury six pounds current
Money

I am I give & bequeath unto my grand son Peter Withinson son of Thomas Withinson
one shilling sterling

I am I give & bequeath unto my son Joseph Withinson two pounds current Money

I am I give & bequeath unto my sons Peter Withinson & Henry Withinson & my
Daughters Polly Withinson & Nanny Withinson & to their Heirs forever all the remainder
& residue of my Estate both real & personal equally to be divided

I am it is my Will & Grace that in case either of my Sons John or Mackay should
