according to the discretion of my Executors. Was for such worldly Estate whereunto
hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give assign & bequeath in the
following manner & form

Item. I give & bequeath unto my Son James Fergusson in Bedford County
one Shilling Sterling

Item. I give & bequeath unto my Son Aaron Fergusson two Pence Before

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Aaron Farguson two Pills & say
that he had run for me to him & his ^{there} forever

Item I give & bequeath unto my grand Daughter Martha Kennedy
Daughter of Archibald Kennedy my side saddle & new & better to her
her heirs forever

Item I give & bequeath unto my grandson William Farguson Son of
my eldest & a bond & half to him & his heirs forever

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Daniel Farguson my new
Satisfaction for what I owe him to him & his heirs forever

Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Kennedy & my grand
Daughter Anne Newby my blocks to be equally divided between them
forever

Now I give & bequeath unto my great grand Daughter Daughter
of my grand Daughter Winna Nueby her Name is Martha
Nueby my Deed that I do not own & what belongs to it to her for
forever

Now I give & bequeath unto my grand Son Rogers Fergusson
& my grand Daughter Winna Nueby all my Estate that I have
not mentioned to be equally divided between them & for the said Rogers
Fergusson whom I do make again my whole and perfect of this
my last Will & Testament and I do do utterly revoke all wills
& testaments all other Wills & Testaments whatsoever signed by me
before this present Day & I do allow this & no other to be my last Will
& Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand &
affixed my seal this tenth Day of February Anno Domini 1771
