Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary ~~James~~

Widd and Colward Motes and to their Heirs and Assigns
I never one more to be divided between my said three sons
Share and Share alike.

Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Mary Archer one
Negro you named Lucy and her increase also my riding
Chair to her her Heirs and Assigns forever.

Item I desire that my estate be not appraised and I doth
hereby appoint my son William Archer Executor of this
my last Will and Testaments. In Witness whereof I the
said Henry Archer have hereunto set my hand and
affixed my seal to this my last Will and Testaments
this Twenty seventh Day of July 1790. Henry Archer Esq
