of said wife many my Land & plantation Negroes Henry and Ned stock of Horses
Cattle hys Household furniture and plantation utensils to him and to his heirs forever

3rd If the said Edmund Edmund should die before he come to his full age I then
give my Land and plantation Negroes Henry & Ned stock of Horses Cattle

and hys Household furniture and plantation utensils to my brother and sister

as becometh (My) John James & sister James & James
Nelly Edmund & Polly Englebin & Nancy Daught to them and to their
heirs forever —

4th I do hereby constitute & appoint Thomas Askeot executor of this my last will and
testament with the others by us made as witnesses my hand and seal this 23rd

of said wife many say Land & plantation. Negroes Henry and Ned stock of horses
 cattle hogs household furniture and plantation utensils to him and to his heirs forever
 if the said Armstrong should die before he come to his full age. Then
 I give my land and plantation. Negroes Henry & Ned stock of horses cattle
 and hogs household furniture and plantation utensils to my brothers and sisters
 as he is named (Ned) John Graves Arthur & James Thomas Graves,
 Sally Quarmant Betty Engustin & Nancy Daugh to him and to their
 heirs forever.
