following, to wit.

all my lands and plantation now here on during her natural life

Now I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Hannah Gibson Daughter of my son
Mr. Gibson the said land and plantation that I have lent to my said Wife
after the Decease of my said Wife. Also one Negro Boy called Joshua to
her, her Heirs and assigns forever.

Now I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Nancy Gibson Daughter of my
son Mr. Gibson one Negro Boy called Moses to her her Heirs and assigns forever.

Now I give and bequeath to my son John Gibson five shillings Sterling to him his Heirs
and assigns forever.

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Now I give and bequith to my well beloved Wife Hannah Giffon all my whole
Estate both Real and personal which I have not already given away to her, her
Heirs and Ufguns forever Truly I appeared and Return Philip Cooper and
Marion Haskins to be my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and
Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my
Seal this fourth day of March In the year of our Lord One thousand Seven
hundred and Eighty Eight. I desire my Estate not to be appraised
