Mother Sally Cary a Black Walnut Table, six Cush. Arm
Chairs and a Bed Head. After the decease of my Mother
Sally Cary it is my will and Desire that the said Negro
Sail and her Child Marianah and their Increase shall
sold at the Discretion of my Executors and the Money a

be divided as follows: My share to William Cary living - then the
current Money. - I give to Humph Cary living - then Edmund
I give to Edmund Cary living - then the Money
which will occur the three Legacies given to my Brothers William
Cary, Humph Cary, & Edmund Cary, then I leave the Balance to be
equally divided between William Cary, Humph Cary, Edmund Cary,
John Cary and Robert Cary but should the My wife or I be
living less than the three Legacies given to my three Brothers
William Cary, Humph Cary, & Edmund Cary in that case then
it to be equally divided between William Cary, Humph Cary, &
Edmund Cary. I also give to Humph Cary my Bay Mare
Saddle and Bridle. I give to my Brothers John Cary & Robert
Cary forty seven Acres of Land in Prince Edward County to
them and their Heirs forever, to be equally divided between
them. I give Peter Moore two hundred Acres of Land
in Prince Edward County to him and his Heirs forever and
all my Estate to the said Peter Moore and his Heirs forever.

in Prince Edward County to run and be there forever
all my Carpenter & Joiner's Tools. - It is my Will &
Desire that my Executors shall make a good and sufficient
Title to Tho^s Gibson for the Lands I sold him lying in this County
by which he makes my Brothers a Deed to the Lands I have
charged of him in Prince Edward County as given to them by
this my last Will. - It is my Desire that should any dispute
arise in dividing the above Lands as given to my Brothers
that Col^o Charles Pellison of Buckingham shall be called on
to say how the Lines shall be run and when so run or laid
off by him shall be binding on all Parties and I leave my
friends Thomas Raley & Isham Raley my whole Sole Exe-
cutors to this my last Will revoking all others as I have here-
unto fixed my Hand and Seal this 27 day of July one thousand
seven hundred and eighty nine
