will } being my sick & low that in perfect memory I give & bequeath my whole estate
within this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following

I Give & bequeath to my dear & well beloved Wife Mary Lacey all & every part of my movable
Estate Endowing her widowhood or natural Life with the same I now leave but that my
eldest Son Archibald Lacey may have Liberty if he desires it to settle himself on the upper
End of my land towards Sublets Line so as not to disturb his Mother in the Plantation
& if my youngest Son Jordan should come of Age before his Mother's Death that he may
have Liberty to settle if he desires it, the Plantation I purchased of Anthony Taylor
Now I give & bequeath to my Son Archibald Lacey the one half of my Land to be laid
off by ^a line beginning at the upper corner of Bernet Taylor's Plantation on the Hundred
Road & so by a direct line to Sublets line on James' line on Tomohawk to him & his heirs

And I give & bequeath the other half of my land to my Son Jordan Lacey to him & his heirs

And I do by a strict Line to Submits on Francis line on Tomchoach to him & his Heirs forever

Item I give & bequeath the other half of my Land to my youngest son Lacy to him & his Heirs forever

Item my Will is that after my Wife's Death or Marriage my moveable Estate be laid off in seven equal Lots to my seven Children I give to them & their Heirs forever

Item I desire that there should be no appraisement of my Estate

I also appoint my eldest son Archibald Lacy Executor of this my last Will & Testament & do hereby disannull & make void all former Wills & Wills by me made & acknowledge this & this only to be my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 22nd Day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & eighty one
