Chesterfield County, Virginia Wills 1785 to 1800
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Be it remembered In the name of God amen Peter Baugh Seneca of the
Will Parish of Dale and County of Chesterfield do make and
restrain this my Last Will and Testament in manner and
form as followeth ^{1st} I leave and send unto my three
Daughters ^{2nd} Mary Sarah, Elizabeth and Hannah Baugh
during their life, or untill they shall intermarry, Part of the
Land and Houses I now live on ^{3rd} One Barn, the Kitchen
Smoke House Dairy and part of the Dwelling house, the
Small Closer below and above Stairs with fifty Acres of Land
adjoining the Creek and Houses with the Orchard, it being
part of the Tract of Land I shall hereafter give to my son
Andrew Baugh. Also fifty Acres of Land to be land off the part

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Adjoining the Swamp and of Tract I shall hereafter give to my son
Robert Bough with a Sufficiency of Firewood and Lumber to sup-
port each part and parcel of Land during the said Term or term
for them the said three Daughters and for each of them use and
Benefit; But they nor either of them shall not Rent Lease or let
the Land or Houses to any Person or Persons without the Consent
of the Father to whom I shall hereafter devise bequeath and give
the Land to

Now I give devise and Bequeath unto my son Robert Bough part of Tract
of Land I purchased of Joseph & Anthony on the South side of the
Swamp and bounded as followeth To begining at the Swamp
at a small Branch thence up the said Branch to a Cornfield
thence on the same Land thence through the said Fence up the
Branch to the Head thence a straight Line to the nearest part of
my Line adjoining the Land of George Courant William Lane
and Charles Norton to the said Swamp thence down the said
Swamp to the place begun at touch the Fifth Line of Land

sent above to my three Daughters Sarah, Elizabeth and Susanna
Baugh and their Determination in the said Land I give to him
the said Robert Baugh the said Land also three Negroes viz
One Negro man named Moses one Negro woman named Palt
and her Child named Rang. One Kitchen bed and Furniture
one Cow Team named Roman to him the said Robert Baugh
his heirs and assigns forever

Item I give Devise and bequeath unto my Son Andrew Baugh
the remaining part of the Tract of Land and Plantation
whereon I now live like a Tract of Eleven Acres of Land I pur-
chased of George Courton, except the Land and ~~House~~ before
sent to my three Daughters Sarah, Elizabeth and Susanna
Baugh and after their determination in the said Land and
House I give the said Tract of Land to my Son Andrew Baugh
also three Negroes viz One Negro man named John One Negro

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My married Daniel and Mary had named Mary One
Small Horse called Ball One feather Bed and Purse one
Duck six Pats, one Pot with one half of my Plantation
Minutes to him the said Andrew has there and after from
him give Deeds and bequath unto my son Peter Daugh all
that of that ~~same~~ tract of Land where he now lives, it being
on the south side of Deep Creek with the Rock of Cattle
and from his house in possession also there a negro boy
named Tompkins one more man named Coll
and one more girl named Lucy (daughter of John) and
the said Andrew have to him the said Peter Daugh his share

Daugh the remaining part of my tract of Land on the
north side of Deep Creek with the Rock of Cattle and he

Two Negroes $\frac{1}{2}$ One Negro boy named Cooper and Negro girl
named Tall with her future increase One feather Bed and Furni-
ture One side Saddle and Bridle One Black Horse that came from
Dick Creek to her the said Susanna Baugh her Hens and
Ufegns forever.

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my daughter Martha Gibbs Two
Negroes $\frac{1}{2}$ one Negro boy named Tom and one Negro girl named
Eggy with her future Increase One Feather Bed and Furniture
One side Saddle and Bridle. She has now in Possession and the
young sorrel Colt that came out of young, sorrel Mare to her the

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Item I give devise and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Sally Pude
Daughter of John Pude One Negro Girl named Claracy and her
future Increase and Bounts Issue to her the said Sally Pude her
Heirs and Assigns forever.

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my daughter Pucella Pude One
Negro woman named Mollie and her future Increase and Bounts
Issue my Bedding, Chair and Trunk to her the said
Pucella Pude her Heirs and Assigns forever.

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my five Children Viz Robert
Andrew, Leah Elizabeth and Luanna Bough all my Crops
and Stock of Cattle, Sheep and Hogs on this Plantation to be
equally divided amongst them Heirs and Assigns forever.

Item I give devise and bequeath my young Mark Anthony More
to be equally divided amongst all my Children Viz Robert,
Andrew, Alexander, Peter, Leah, Elizabeth Luanna Bough

Penilla Pridg and Martha Gibbs to them and then then for
them I leave and lend to my three Daughters viz Sarah, Eliza
and Luanna Baugh three Negroes named Peter Jagg
and Hellen with the remaining of my household Kitchen
Furniture and Plantation Utensils not household devices
and give away untill they and each of them shall in
forming or depart this Life after which determination
I give devise and bequeath unto my Son Andrew Baugh
the Negro fellow named Peter and the Negro woman
named Jagg and my old sword more to him the said
Andrew Baugh his Heirs and Assigns forever And I do
give devise and bequeath to my three Daughters Martha
Gibbs Elizabeth (one Luanna Baugh the above mentioned
Negro woman with her future Increase to them their Heirs
and Assigns forever to be equally divided and also the
above mentioned Household Kitchen Furniture to be equally
divided amongst all my Children viz Robert Alexander

decided amongst all my children by Robert Alexander
Peter Andrew Sarah Elizabeth and Susanna Baugh,
Percilla Pude and Martha Gibbs to them their Heirs and
Assigns forever. My Will and desire is and I Ordain it to be
that after my last Debt and funeral Expenses are paid
I give devise and bequeath unto my free Daughters Sarah
Elizabeth and Susanna Baugh Percilla Pude Martha
Gibbs all the money that I have in the house with all
the Debt that may be then due to my Estate to them
their Heirs and Assigns forever. I do Order and my Will
and desire is that my Estate be not Interventured or appraised
I do nominate constitute and Appoint John Peter Alexander
Baugh Peter Baugh jr ~~and~~ and Andrew Baugh Executors
of this my Last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof
I the said Peter Baugh hath hereunto set my Hand and
affixed my Seal this Twelfth day of May One Thousand
Seven Hundred and Eighty Eight.
