for Ever.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Baugh one Negro Girl
named Lucy one feather bed and furniture to her and her heirs
forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Richard Baugh one Negro Boy named
Africa and that part of my Land purchased of Thomas Allen and after
my wife's Decease that part called Ryfelo to him & his heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Archibald Baugh one Negro boy named
Ashia and that part of my Land I purchased of Oliver and that part

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Jane Baugh one negro girl named Betty one Feather bed and furniture to her and her heirs for Ever.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Baugh one negro girl named Lucy one feather bed and furniture to her and her heirs for Ever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Richard Baugh one negro Boy named Affuca and that part of my Land purchased of Thomas Ashin and after my wife's Decease that part called Ryfolds to him & his heirs for Ever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Archibald Baugh one negro boy named Ashia and that part of my Land I purchased of Oliver and that part of my Land running from Bollings line to Defear's after my wife's Decease but provided that either of my Children dies before they come of age or are married that their part to be divided between the rest except the Land

and Peter Jones my Executors of the said last will and Testament my seal and
